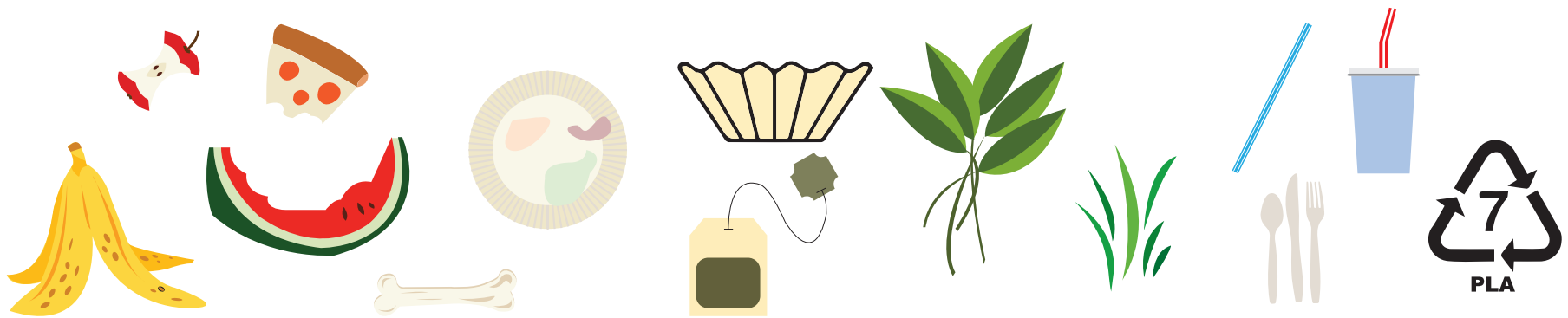


Accepted Compostable Material at UCLA



Food

Any organic material

Bones are okay

Fruit Peels
Vegetable Scraps
Grains, Pasta
Bread
Dairy
Meat, Bones

Eggshells
Tea Leaves
Coffee Grounds
Liquids

Generally, all foods are compostable.

NO Trash or Recyclables

Paper Products

Paper products that have been in contact with food and liquids

Tea bags and coffee filters are okay

Plates
Cups
Bags
To-Go Boxes
Paper Wraps
Napkins
Paper Towels

Tissues
Soiled papers
Greasy Boxes
Coffee Filters
Tea Bags
Sugar Packets
Wood Stirrers

Unsure? Try the rip test! If it rips like paper and there are no layers of plastic or foil, you can recycle it. If not, dispose in the landfill.

NO Wax or Plastic Lined Materials

Yard Waste

Plant matter

Grass clippings
Leaves
Plants
Branches

Generally, all plants except for palm fronds, eucalyptus, and pine needles are compostable.

**NO Palm Fronds
NO Eucalyptus
NO Pine Needles
NO Dirt or Soil**

Compostable Plastics (PLA)

Must say Compostable Plastic or have PLA #7 symbol

Cups
To-Go Lids
Serving Trays
Straws
Utensils

Unsure? Read the label or look for the PLA #7 symbol! Items that are BPI Certified are 100% compostable.

NO Plastic
